





SYNOPSIS

Aune, a German lawyer, travels to South America where she writes ecological stories. On the island of Amantani in Lake Titicaca (Peru and Bolivia border) she falls in love with a married musician.

The environmentalist begins a project to bring water to the high communities of the island, but the authorities reject the couple's adulterous relationship and both have to flee to the other side of the lake in Copacabana, Bolivia. Aune is diagnosed with a chronic illness and returns from Germany with funds for the water project. Aune mysteriously vanished and at the same time the musician also disappeared and is seen spending money.

Aune's disappearance sparks an international search and the eventual discovery that she was murdered. In Germany, experts travel to South America; In Peru, a journalist wants the fugitive musician and main crime's suspect to be caught and in Bolivia the crime is reconstructed. Family and friends keep looking for answers to the disappearance of the beloved German activist.

DIRECTOR ROBERTO PAZOS




The Gringa and the Musician is the Feature Film directing debut for Roberto Pazos. Roberto is the host and founder of Peruanos en el Mundo, a weekly travel show that has aired nationwide in the USA, Canada and Peru. On the air since 2015, the program has traveled to more than 50 countries to highlight Peruvians overseas.

Roberto is also the founder of Filmed In Peru, a showcase of Peruvian films with editions in New Jersey and New York. He also was the co-manager of the April 2024 OUTshine Film Festival in Miami.

In 1995, Roberto won the Grand Prix at the Port de Bouc International Youth Report Festival with is short film debut "Educadores de la Calle" (Street's Educators.) Since then he has produced two other short films and was a Peabody Award winner during his tenure at CNN. He has also worked at both Univision and Telemundo networks. He is a native of Peru and holds both a bachelors degree and a Masters of Business degree from Florida International University.





EDITOR AND POST PRODUCTION ROBERTO BARBA




Roberto Barba brings decades of film production and film editing experience to The Gringa and the Musician.

He lives in Lima, Peru.


